

BOATER SAFETY TIP - AIDS TO NAVIGATION

Like road signs, these aids to navigation indicate the proper direction you should take out on the water.

WHEN RETURNING FROM THE SEA – AND HEADED UPSTREAM...



Green Lateral Marker
Keep this marker on your left or port side.



Red Lateral Marker
Keep this marker on your right or starboard side.



Red & Green Lateral Marker
You can pass this marker on either side – but the top-most color is recommended.



Nun Buoys
Keep this marker on your right or starboard side.




Can Buoys
Keep this marker on your left or port side



Day-Marks
Keep green squares (odd) on your left and red triangles (even) on the right

RED. RIGHT. RETURNING.

REMEMBER:
Keep the RED markers on your RIGHT side when RETURNING upstream.
